Guidelines & Rules	<p>1. General Rules</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Eligibility<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Open to all enrolled college students.○ Players must register before participating.2. Equipment<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Standard-size football (college regulation size).○ Targets such as goalposts, marked zones, or nets at different distances.3. Game Setup<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ The competition area will have designated target zones with different point values.○ Players must kick from a marked spot (penalty spot, free-kick line, or designated area). <p>2. Competition Rules</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Kicking Attempts<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Each player gets 5 kicks per round.○ The ball must be kicked from behind the designated line.○ Stepping over the line before kicking results in a penalty or invalid kick.2. Scoring System<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ 1 point will get once target line cross○ In case of a tie, a sudden-death round will determine the winner.3. Time Limit<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Players must complete all kicks within 60-90 seconds per round.○ Exceeding the time results in missed kicks.4. Fouls & Disqualifications<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Any form of cheating (e.g., crossing the line, using an unapproved ball) results in disqualification.○ Players must follow fair play and respect the referee's decisions.

3. Safety & Fair Play

1. **Players must warm up** before kicking to prevent injuries.
2. **No rough play or interference** with other participants.
3. **Officials' decisions are final** in case of disputes.
