Rules / Guidelines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The competition is open to individual participants only. ● Performances must be based on traditional folk dance forms. ● The time limit for each performance is 4–6 minutes. ● Pre-recorded folk music should be submitted in MP3 format prior to the event. ● Costumes, makeup, and accessories must reflect authentic folk tradition. ● Vulgarity, offensive gestures, or inappropriate content are strictly prohibited. ● Props are allowed only if they are safe, non-hazardous, and culturally appropriate. ● Use of fire, water, glass, sharp objects, or hazardous materials is not permitted. ● Exceeding the time limit will result in disqualification. ● Participants must report to the venue at least 30 minutes before their scheduled performance. ● The judges’ decision will be final and binding.
