Discipline Rules and Regulations For Nirmalites

1. Campus entry and exit:

- a. **Main Gate:** Students entry and exit will be monitored strictly through QR code scanning system. All students should keep their ID with them. Students under any disciplinary action will not be permitted to enter the campus on these days.
- b. **Quadrangle entrance:** during Music show all entrances except the main student entrance to the quadrangle will be closed (including main reception, arts reception, building gap etc.). Student ID card will serve as the ticket of entry for Evening music program.
- c. All other possible entrances to the campus will be barricaded or manned.
- d. Students coming in their own vehicles should use the allocated parking areas alone. Only driver alone permit to enter inside the campus with vehicle all other passengers should get down at the main entrance. Parking space is limited inside the campus.
- e. Students coming in modified vehicles with loud noise will not be permitted to enter the campus.
- f. Once the vehicles are parked, students will not be permitted into the parking area until day's program finished.
- g. Stall supply vehicles:
 - Such vehicles will only be allowed inside the campus by presenting gate pass. Gate passes will be available from General Co-ordinator.
 - Time: Morning before 8.00 AM, Afternoon 12.00pm -1.00 PM, Evening 3.00 to 4.00 PM on Day 2
- h. The vehicles coming for **Auto show** should enter the campus before 8.00 am on that day or they can also stay back from previous day evening.
- i. **College Bus:** College buses will arrive on campus as usual and depart after the completion of day's programme. ID Cards are mandatory to enter in to college buses.

2. Permitted areas for student use:

- a. **All Colleges:** All classrooms, staff rooms, Library, Labs & other areas will be closed from 9:30am (except programme venues). Students can use their classrooms to keep their bags etc. before 9:30am. The classrooms will be re-opened for lunch for 1hr from 12:30 pm to 1:30pm (For the students who have bought lunch from home only). After this, classrooms will be re-opened for students to collect their bags before they leave.
- b. NCAS Sandwich block and NCHS will remain closed between 9:30am to 12:30pm and 1:30pm to 6:00pm (except program venues).
- c. **Green room:** There will be green rooms open in the ground floor and first floor next to the main stage, for boys and girls
- d. **First aid room:** First Aid room is set up in the NCHS reception area. Any students wanting to rest etc. are welcome to use these rooms. Entry to the first aid rooms will be permitted upon checking student ID cards only.
- e. **The Nutmeg Café:** The Café will be closed and students can take the meals from the stall inside the quadrangle
- f. **Snack Bar:** Will remain closed during the day.
- g. Students are not expected to use areas, near the Nutmeg Shades, Bus Parking area, Bike Parking area etc. at any time during the day. These areas will be thoroughly supervised and not student found to be misusing these areas will face strict actions.

3. Code of Conduct:

- a. All students should maintain a respectful, courteous, and professional attitude at all times inside the campus.
- b. Students are required to adhere to a modest dress code while on campus.
- c. Harassment, bullying, or discriminatory behaviour of any form will not be tolerated. Any student/students found engaging in such acts will be removed from the campus.
- d. Use or carrying of prohibited items (drugs, liquor, any kind of weapons, fire crackers etc...) will be punishable and culprits will be handover to police.

- e. Follow instructions from college authorities, volunteers, and security personnel at all times.
- f. Since Laksh is a public program, Police presence will be there throughout the program.
- g. Institution can have all the rights to change the rules and regulations.
